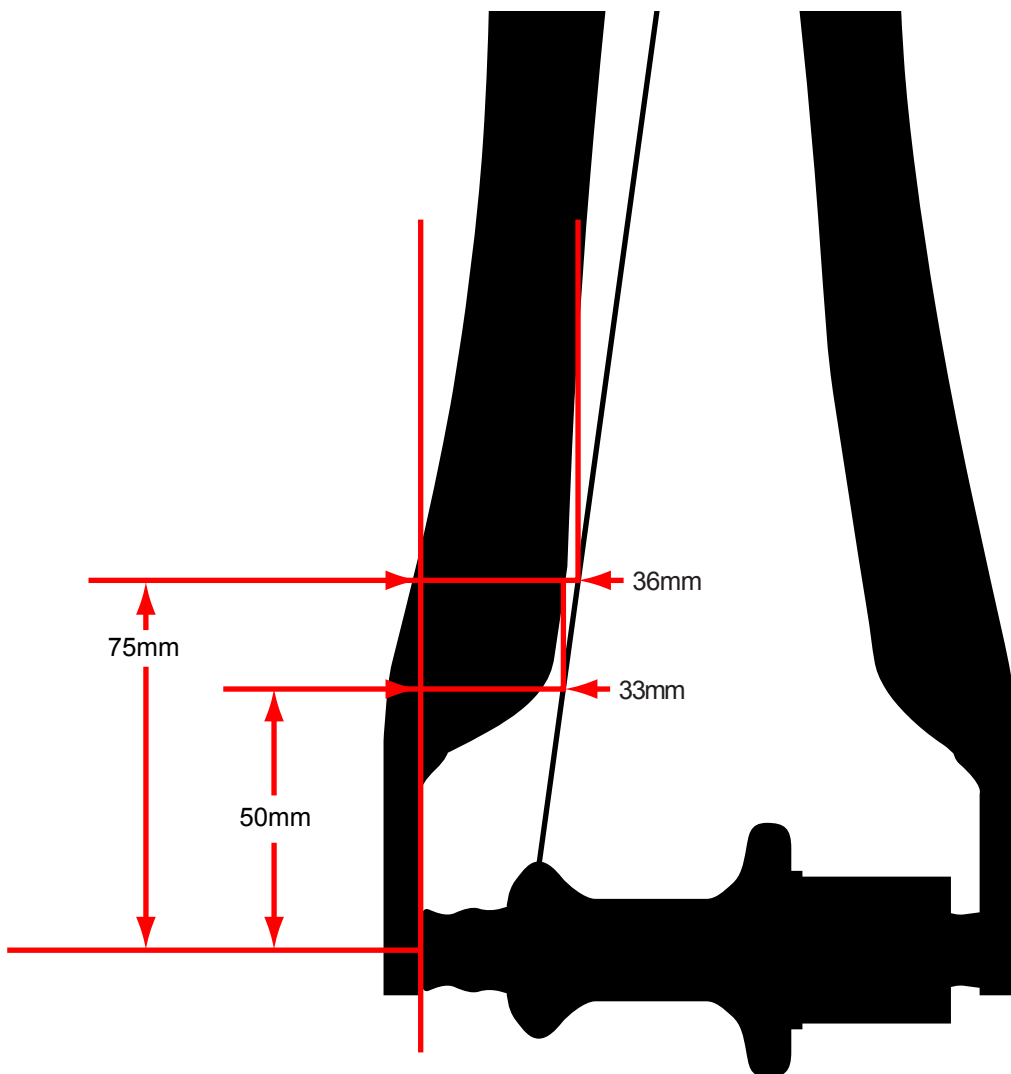


2009 P4/WHEEL COMPATIBILITY



To know if your wheel's spokes will fit between the chain stays of the P4 put the wheel in question into any frame. Place a ruler flush against the inboard side of the rear drop out so that the ruler points to the front of the bike.

Measure 50 mm towards the front of the bike from the centerline of the rear wheel's axle. With another ruler placed at right angles to the original ruler, measure from that 50 mm point towards the centerline of the bike. If the distance to the outboard aspect of the spoke of the wheel in question is more than 33 mm at this point you will not experience any issue with using that wheel with your P4.

If the distance to the outboard aspect of the spoke of the wheel in question is between 31.5-33 mm your wheel still may work with the P4 but will depend on the lateral stiffness of the wheel.

Measurements of 31.5 mm or less should not be used on the P4.
